

BOCCIA WORLD OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS Poznań'2015 POLAND

1st INFORMATION



ORGANIZER: Polish Disabled Boccia Federation

DATE: 16th to 22nd of June 2015

(If the number of entries is lower than the maximum accepted, the arrival would be on the 17th)

VENUE: Academy of Physical Education in Poznan, Poland

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

All participant nation must have the fees on good standing with BISFed with their membership for 2015 paid in full. Minimum age for competition is 15 years as of the 1st of January 2015

RULES:

As disposed out by the BISFed in the most recent edition of rules published on the official website www.bisfed.com.

ENTRY CRITERIA:

BISFed will do its best to ensure a fair and equitable method to registration for the World Open Event (WOE) in 2015.

- The first step of registration (intent to register) will be coordinated by BISFed
- The minimum number of athletes that must be registered to make the competition possible is 56 and the maximum is 120 in total, being 100 in the individual competition.
- If the event is oversubscribed, BISFed will allocate a minimum of 50% and maximum of 80% of the total event entry to nations from Europe. The general percentage from each region should also be considered.
- All nations who express an interest in an event, by the deadline of the organizing committee, will receive at least one entry slot, in at least one class
- The number of entry slots awarded per nation may be less than the number requested.
- Each nation will be required to indicate their priority for entry in to the Team and Pair events and for the individual events

- A slight prioritization could be given to nations who have not attended a World Open to date, particularly any nation who was declined from participating in a WOE in 2014 due to an event being oversubscribed.

DIVISIONS OF PLAY AND MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITOR PER NATION:

Individuals: BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4	3 per class
Pairs: BC3, BC4	3 per Pair
Team: BC1/BC2	5 in Team

However, if you are competing on a Team or Pair, it is possible that you might not enter all the athletes on the individual events.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS PER CATEGORY PREFERRED:

INDIVIDUAL:	96
TEAM & PAIRS:	28

Depending on the number of entries received, BISFed will make the final arrangements for the number of entrants in each class, considering the number of courts available (8) and days of competition (5), as well as the maximum athletes as possible and a fair distribution of the slots by the nations.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF STAFF:

The staff ratio is 1:1.

Apart of this is allowed:

- 1 coach per Pair or Team
- 1 Team leader
- 1 medical staff

Extra staff will be accepted. Costs for extra staff:

regular entry fee 530 EURO plus 250 EURO extra fee (total 780 €).

ENTRY FEE:

530 EURO (accommodation, all meals from dinner 16th June until breakfast 22nd June, local transport : hotel – venue; transport from / to airport Poznań)

Extra day per person **100 EURO** (accommodation with breakfast, transport from/to airport Poznań)

Extra single rooms : additional charge of **70 EURO / day/room**

(Teams with odd number of participants will not be charged with an extra fee for the single room)

Extra staff : regular fee **530 EURO** and extra fee of **250 EURO** will be charged (**total 780 EURO**).

DEADLINES:

First Entry deadline – intention to compete,
by number and category of athletes and staff

Payment of **1000 EURO per delegation**

Delegations not accomplishing the deadline will not receive any other relative information and will take no part on the event.

The HOC will confirm for each delegation the final number of accepted players and staff, according to BISFed criteria.

ATHLETE SUBSTITUTION

Athlete's substitution will be allowed only for ill or injured athletes no later than the 10th of June. Medical documentation will be required in these cases and must be considered and accepted just with the approval from the Technical Delegate appointed by BISFed.
